CO-OP SOLAR PROGRAM

CORPORATE COMMITMENT

Energy needs for members voluntarily participating in the Wabash Valley Power Alliance Co-op Solar program will be supplied from the environmentally preferred source of solar power. Currently that source has a higher cost than most other sources of power. The Solar Rider currently reflects an increased cost of forty-two cents (\$.42) per block per month over the REMC's standard rates.

It is our hope that as members choose alternative solar power, additional investments will be made in environmentally friendly generation.

AVAILABILITY

Available to REMC members in all territory served by the REMC and to any member of the REMC for single-phase or multi-phase service located on or adjacent to the lines of the REMC and suitable and adequate for receiving the service requested.

Members may choose the number of blocks in which they would like to participate up to the lessor of the average monthly usage of the account or 83 blocks. Each block is currently estimated to provide on average 43 kWh per month.

MONTHLY RATE

The Solar Power Rider is in addition to the REMC's standard rates and charges.
